Ambucs has given away over 10,000 AmTrykes and given over \$7,000,000 in scholarships to therapists. For the 2008-2009 school year, Ambucs awarded 224 scholarships.

The following two pictures are of Leroy Duran and Cristel Salinas riding their new AmTrykes. Leroy (younger) was in a horrible car accident two years ago and has had several major surgeries. His rehabilitation journey has been long and tough. Cristel had a stroke that significantly impaired his physical abilities. Leroy and Cristel are not allowed to drive and have to have a family member or a caretaker for any venture outside of their homes. We hope that their new AmTrykes will give them the opportunity to travel outside their homes while getting very therapeutic exercise.
